Chorus: Behold the Lamb of God Behold the Lamb of God that taketh away the sins of the world.

Alto Air: He was Despised

He was despised and rejected of men; a man of sorrows and acquainted with grief. He gave his back to the smitters and his cheeks to them that plucked off the hair: he hid not his face from shame and spitting.

Chorus: Surely, He Hath Borne Our Griefs Surely, he hath borne our griefs and carried our sorrows; he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities; the chastisement of our peace was upon him.

Bass Air: The Trumpet Shall Sound The trumpet shall sound and the dead shall be raised in corruptible and we shall be changed.

Alto Recitative: Then Shall Be Brought to Pass Then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written: death is swallowed up in victory.

Worthy is the Lamb that was slain and hath redeemed us to God by his blood, to receive power, and riches, and wisdom, and strength, and honor, and glory and blessing. Blessing and honor, glory and power, be unto him that sitteth upon the throne and unto the Lamb for ever and ever. Amen.
